Sir,

While forwarding a copy of the inspection report since received from the West Bengal State Council of Higher Education (WBSCHE) for establishment of a self-financed B.Ed. College, I am directed by the order of the Governor to say that on the basis of the said report the Government in Higher Education Department has 'No objection' for establishment of a self financed B.Ed. College in the name of Siksha Bikash Seba Foundation B.Ed. College, P.O. Chotkhanda, Distt. Burdwan, strictly on self-financing basis subject to approval of the National Council for Teacher Education and affiliation by the Burdwan University and also fulfillment of the following terms and conditions :

- i) The proposed college shall be guided by NCTE norms in respect of appointment of teaching staff, purchase of books, audio-visual material and automation of the library.
- ii) The College will continue to organize and equip the laboratories as per stipulation of NCTE. Other infrastructure to be maintained as per NCTE.
- iii) Fee Structure will be as per instructions of the Affiliating University. Stern action shall be taken if any irregularities are found in this regard.
- iv) Intake capacity will be as per NCTE norms.
- v) Appointment of Faculty already made/to be made in future and their pay and allowances must follow the latest NCTE, UGC and State Govt. norms. It is advised to make payment to the staff of the college through A/c payee cheque drawn on a (preferably) Nationalized Bank. Stern action shall be taken if any irregularities are found in this regard.
- vi) In respect of maintenance of academic and financial discipline the proposed college will strictly follow rules/norms of NCTE (in strict observance of the latest notification)/State Government/any other regulatory body as may be applicable issued from time to time and relevant conditions/rules of the Affiliating University in this regard especially with respect to the minimum number of teaching days in an academic session as stipulated by the Affiliating University/NCTE.
- vii) Expert(s), duly authorized by the WBSCHE/State Government may make 'surprise visit' to the college for rapid, on the spot assessment of the quality of functioning.
- viii) The college will be outside the purview of West Bengal Colleges (Payment of Salaries Act, 1978) and under no circumstances the Government will bear responsibility for the salaries of the Teaching or Non-teaching staff as well as other expenses either fully or partly.
